APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Membership Application:** Applicant must provide a completed application.
 - Two References:** Applicant must provide two references inclusive of each reference's name, address, and phone number. Please inform references to expect a call from NCBW.
 - Sponsorship:** Applicant must have demonstrated evidence of active community involvement and be sponsored by one active financial member. If applicant has not demonstrated or can not provide verifiable active community involvement two active financial members must sponsor applicant.
 - Statement of Intent:** Applicant must provide a statement of intent inclusive of the following items:
 - 1) What interests you in becoming a member?
 - 2) What value will you add to the chapter and what area of expertise / interest will you use to benefit the chapter?
 - 3) How do you hope to benefit from membership?
 - 4) State definitely whether you can volunteer no less than three hours per month to NCBW activities.
 - 5) List affiliations with other organizations and whether you are active or not active at this time.

- Fall Membership Dues - \$225.00:** Dues are assessed at the time of acceptance.
 - Spring Membership Dues - \$125.00:** Dues are assessed at the time of acceptance. Spring dues are pro-rated.
 - Associate Membership Dues - \$150.00:** Associate membership is for those who may not have the time to commit, but would like to support the organization through association. *An associate membership is extended only to previous members and includes the following restrictions:*
 - *Can not vote*
 - *Can not hold office*
 - *Can not Chair Committees*
